PUBLICATIONS


Real Time 2026 will keep up to **three records** of your contributions:

- **Posters, Oral** and **Mini-oral** presentations will be available on the **Indico Conference website** in a **public section**;
- **Papers** will be available in a conference record (CR) on the **Indico Conference website** with **limited access** to attendees only;
- **Authors can submit their articles to IEEE Transactions on Nuclear Science (TNS)**. Acceptance is not automatic: The papers will undergo a thorough review according to scientific literature standards. Accepted manuscripts will be published in a **special issue of TNS**, typically **about 10 months after the conference**. However, accepted articles are available online prior to their print publication in the special issue, shortly after acceptance.

SUBMISSION DEADLINES

- Posters: **21 MAY, 2026**
- Oral and mini-oral presentations: **day before your presentation**
- Papers for the Conference Record and TNS: **JUNE 29, 2026**



PREPARING YOUR MANUSCRIPT

- Go to the [NPSS webpage with publication instructions](#) and review the information contained therein
- Authors must prepare their manuscripts using a predefined template. Download the appropriate template under [IEEE article template](#). Templates are available for Microsoft Word and LaTeX
- On the IEEE article template webpage, select *IEEE Template Selector*, then *Transactions, Journal and Letters*, and finally choose the name of the publication (*IEEE Transactions on Nuclear Science*)
- When your manuscript is ready, check it through the [IEEE PDF Checker](#)



CONFERENCE RECORD

Once ready, upload your manuscript to the section dedicated to your contribution on the conference Indico website

➤ Use the following naming convention for your contribution:

❖ **CR#nnn_authorSurname** where

➤ *nnn* (three digits) is the contribution ID assigned to your paper

❖ check the contribution list or acceptance email

➤ *authorSurname* is the lowercase surname of the primary author

➤ Example: the CR file for the paper

**Contribution ID: 8, Software-Assisted Event Builder for Belle II Experiment,
Dmytro Levit et al.**

➤ should be named **CR#008_levit**



IEEE TRANSACTIONS ON NUCLEAR SCIENCE

- **Manuscripts that**
 - **have followed all the steps described above**
 - **are presented at the conference**
- are eligible for publication in the TNS special issue on the IEEE Real Time Conference.
- Go to [IEEE Transactions on Nuclear Science Author Portal](#) and log in (create a new account, if necessary)
- Follow the link to start a new submission in the authors' area
- Follow the step-by-step instructions to enter your information and upload your manuscript files. Be sure to select "**Real Time Conference 2026**" as the "**Type**".



IEEE TRANSACTIONS ON NUCLEAR SCIENCE



- TNS is a hybrid journal. If your paper is accepted for publication:
- you can choose to have it published **open access** upon commitment to pay the current open access fee, and after you execute the appropriate CC-BY license.
- If you decline to pay the open access fee, you will be asked, upon acceptance, to execute **a copyright transfer agreement**. If you have not chosen open access publishing, IEEE will not publish your accepted paper until the copyright transfer agreement is executed
- **Please mention at least three preferred reviewers**. Good candidates include colleagues working in the same field (not from the authors' institutions), or your session conveners

MANUSCRIPT REVIEW PROCESS



- **You will likely be asked to review papers presented at the conference and submitted to TNS.**
- **Agreeing to review other authors' papers should be fair and an integral part of the publication process.**
 - **Invited reviewers who fail to respond, accept, submit their review, or complete their assignments on time are the primary cause of lengthy review process times.**
- **Papers accepted for publication will be published once the authors have completed all assigned review tasks.**
