

Run a survey among our members to get:

Contact information about their national physical society (if they are not already a national physical society).

Ask if they have an ECS national network (in science and in physics) and of what type.

Reach out to physical societies to see:

-if their membership includes physics teachers or not. In case it does not, ask them if there is an association of physics teachers in their country and if they keep frequent connections with them or not. If they have a connection with them, whether they organize some joint activities and which ones. Indicate language used in these activities.

-if they have a subsection on early career scientists and what they do. Also, if they relate to physics students.

-if they are affiliated with a regional physical society and which one.

-if they are also members of another international union, which ones. Can they pay all these dues?
