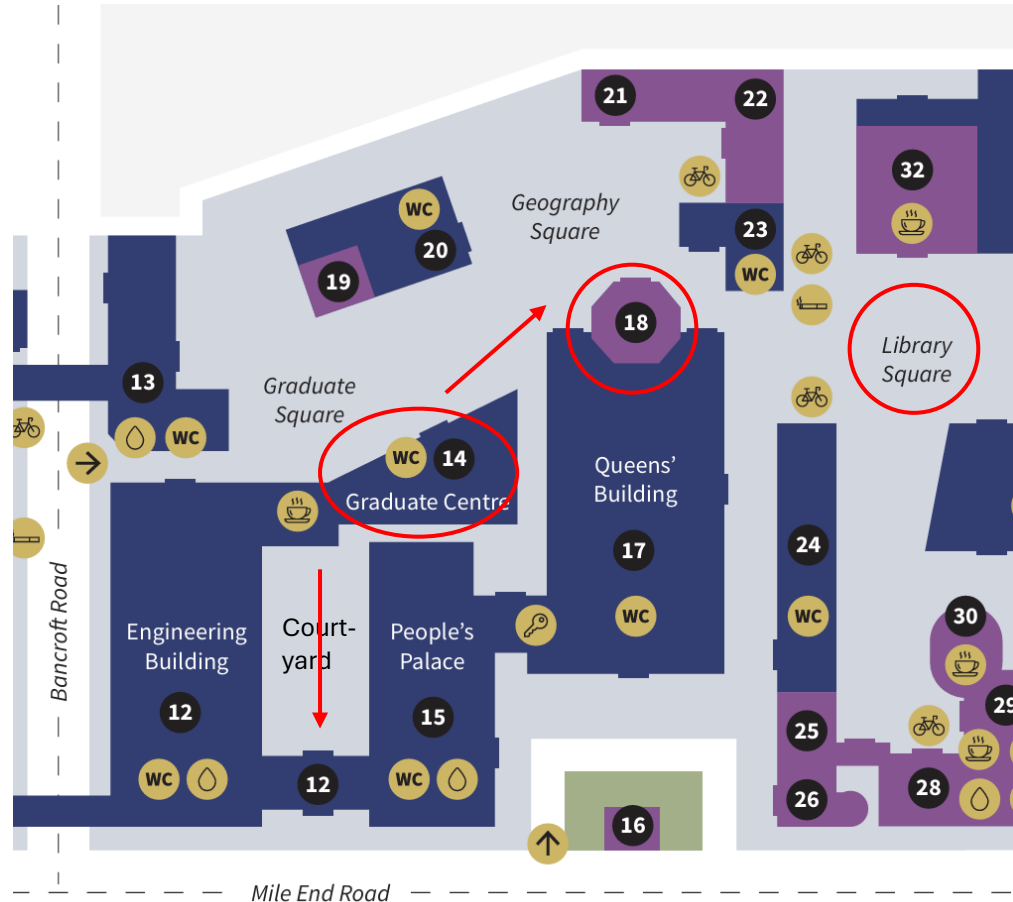

Where are we?



- Graduate Center (14)
