Frontiers is a fully open-access and online journal

A range of different paper styles are offered. The most relevant styles for PSD14 are probably the following:

- **Original Research Paper** – a full-length research paper featuring unpublished data
- **Techniques and Methods Paper** – a significant new method, protocol, or technique. This can include results, either completed or anticipated
- **Review Paper** – either full length, or a briefer mini Review.
- **Brief Research Report** – useful for presenting results in a brief format. Maximum 4000 words and 4 figures/tables



Publication Charges

Frontiers uses a publication fee, or Author Publication Charge (APC)

The cost of the APC varies, depending on which journal you wish to use, and the style of your paper:

- The APC for Frontiers in Detector Science and Technology is slightly lower than the APC for Frontiers in Physics
 - The shorter paper styles have a lower APC

Overall, the APC ranges from CHF 1750 – CHF 2695 (£1575 - £2425)

Options for fee support:

1. Some Universities have fee discount agreements with Frontiers (including CERN)
2. The conference has a limited number of 50% fee waivers

Please use the Online Form on the conference website to request a 50% fee waiver – application deadline is 1st October
