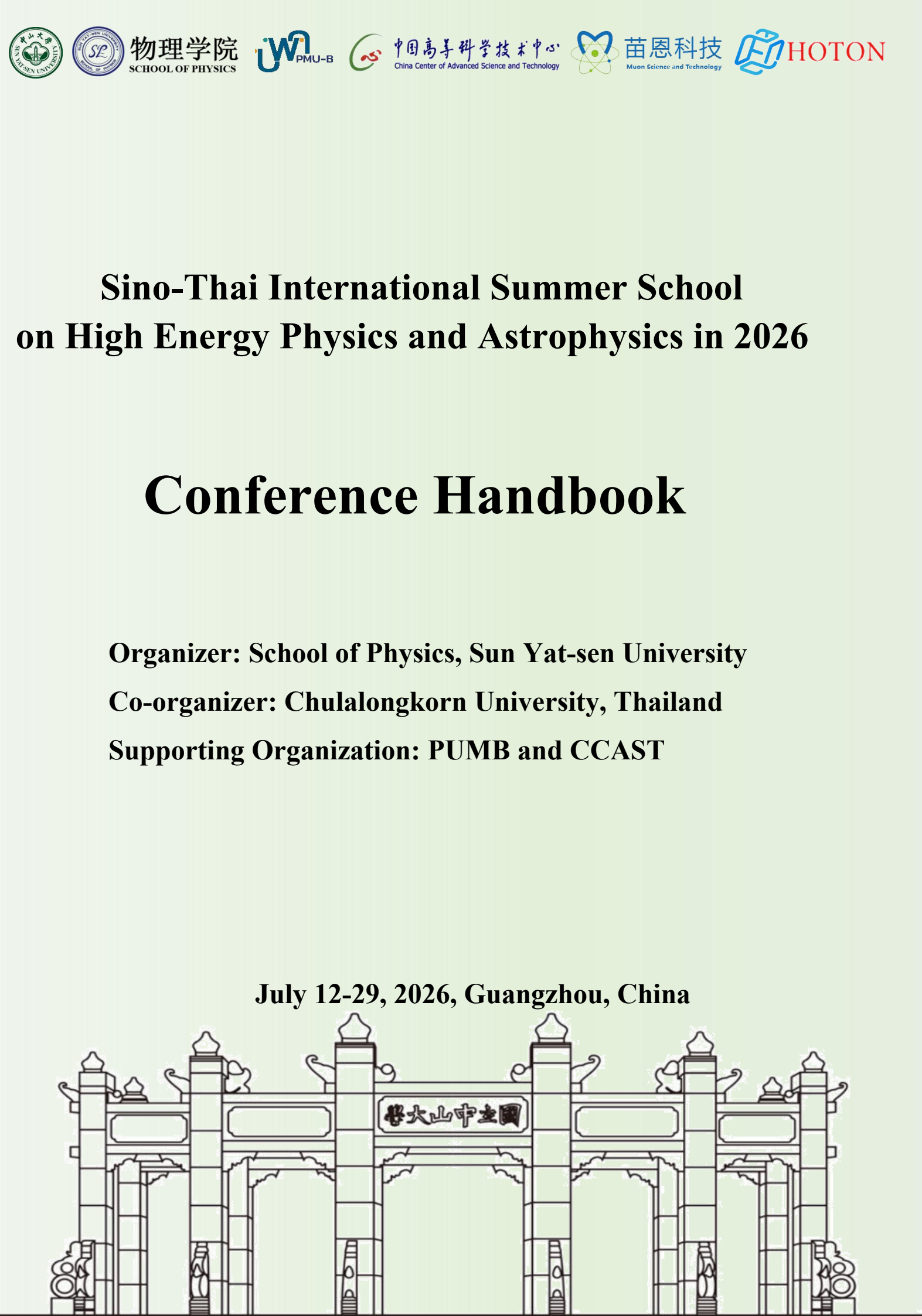

## **Introduction to Sun Yat-sen University**

Sun Yat-sen University was personally founded in 1924 by the great national hero, patriot, and great pioneer of China's democratic revolution, Sun Yat-sen. It was jointly established by early leaders of the Communist Party of China. It is one of the important birthplaces for the spread of Marxism in China, with fine revolutionary traditions, patriotic struggle, and outstanding character pursuits. Sun Yat-sen University was originally named National Guangdong University. After Dr. Sun Yat-sen passed away, the university was officially named National Sun Yat-sen University in 1926.

Today's Sun Yat-sen University was formed in October 2001 by the merger of Sun Yat-sen University and Sun Yat-sen Medical University, which were separated after the 1952 departmental adjustment. Under the strong leadership of the Party and the state, and with the care and support of the Ministry of Education, Guangdong Province, and the local governments of Guangzhou, Shenzhen, Zhuhai, and other locations, Sun Yat-sen University has carried forward its comprehensive, research-oriented, and open educational characteristics and accelerated the construction of a world-class university with Chinese characteristics.

In September 1999, the Zhuhai Municipal People's Government and Sun Yat-sen University officially signed an agreement to cooperate in building the Zhuhai campus of Sun Yat-sen University; In January 2000, the Ministry of Education approved the construction of Sun Yat-sen University's Zhuhai campus. In September 2015, the Shenzhen Municipal Government signed a memorandum of understanding with Sun Yat-sen University to jointly establish the Shenzhen campus; In December of the same year, the Ministry of Education approved the construction of the Shenzhen campus. Thus, Sun Yat-sen University has formed a coordinated development pattern of three campuses and five campuses, rooted in the three core cities of the Guangdong-Hong Kong-Macao Greater Bay Area—Guangzhou, Zhuhai, and Shenzhen. Each campus is coordinated in planning and differentiated development, jointly supporting the university's high-quality, intangible development.。

In recent years, while strengthening traditional advantageous disciplines in arts, sciences, and medicine, Sun Yat-sen University has worked hard to enhance engineering development, filling gaps in agronomy and arts, making the range of disciplines more complete, and forming a comprehensive disciplinary framework for the development of arts, sciences, medicine, engineering, and agriculture. The Guangzhou campus focuses on enhancing traditional strong disciplines in humanities, sciences, and medicine; the Zhuhai campus focuses on developing deep sea, deep space, deep earth, and deep blue discipline clusters; the Shenzhen campus focuses on building new medical and engineering disciplines. The university's comprehensive educational advantages and distinctive features are becoming increasingly prominent, with discipline strength ranking among the top universities in China.

## **Introduction to School of Physics, Sun Yat-sen University**

The physics department of Sun Yat-sen University was founded in 1924. In 1952, the Department of Physics at Lingnan University was merged into the Department of Physics at Sun Yat-sen University. In

1981, the doctoral program in theoretical physics and optics was reinstated; In 1984, he participated in the establishment of the first national key laboratories — the "State Key Laboratory of Ultrafast Laser Spectroscopy"; In 1985, the first national postdoctoral research stations in physics were established; In 1993, it was approved to establish a national physics talent training base; In 1998, the physics discipline became one of the first first-level disciplines authorized for doctoral and master's degrees. After a century of accumulation, it has a profound cultural heritage.

In December 2015, in response to development needs, the School of Physical Science and Engineering Technology was renamed the School of Physics, with the restructured school focusing more on the discipline of physics. In recent years, the school has adhered to Xi Jinping Thought on Socialism with Chinese Characteristics for a New Era as its guiding principle, comprehensively strengthened Party leadership, kept pace with the connotative development of higher education and the pace of the university's "Double First-Class" initiative, and achieved leapfrog progress in all aspects.

In terms of discipline development, the school "faces academic frontiers, major national strategic needs, and national and regional economic and social development," adheres to "entering the mainstream, leading the trend, and going global," optimizes the layout of discipline development, strengthens the three traditional strengths of theoretical physics, condensed matter physics, and optics, consolidates particle physics, develops soft matter physics, and newly builds China's first high-energy inelastic neutron scattering time-of-flight spectrometer, a 200TW ultrafast femtosecond laser, and a neutrino coherent scattering detection system. In the Ministry of Education's fifth round of discipline evaluation, Sun Yat-sen University's physics discipline received an A- rating, and in recent years, its academic rankings across various universities and universities have consistently ranked among the top nationwide. In May 2026, ESI ranked within the top 1,000 globally (0.819‰), ranking 84th globally.

In terms of talent cultivation, the school has the Department of Physics and the Department of Optics and Optical Engineering, offers two undergraduate programs under the "Double Ten Thousand Plan" in Physics and Optoelectronic Information Science and Engineering, and has a national-level Physics Experimental Teaching Demonstration Center and a national base for basic science research and teaching talent training in physics. The school insists on student growth as the center, focusing on the training goals of "solid foundation, broad vision, and strong innovation," implementing first-class discipline construction into first-class talent cultivation, establishing a talent cultivation system that links the first and second classrooms, and has been selected for national talent cultivation strategies such as the "Top Program 2.0." At the undergraduate stage, "strengthen the foundation and set ambitions," and at the master's and doctoral stages, "advance to the frontier and strive for innovation," striving to build a cradle for training physicists.

## **Introduction to Ruyuan**

Ruyuan Yao Autonomous County is located in Shaoguan City, Guangdong Province. It's known as the "Hometown of the World's Overmountain Yao" and is famous for its rich Yao culture and natural scenery.

Situated in northern Guangdong and under the jurisdiction of Shaoguan City, it borders Wujiang District of Shaoguan to the east, Yangshan County of Qingyuan to the west, Yingde City of Qingyuan to the south, Lechang City to the north, and touches Yizhang County of Hunan Province at its northwest corner. With a long history, it was officially established during the Song Dynasty in 1167, giving it more than 850 years of history. The local culture blends Yao culture, Hakka culture, and revolutionary red culture, creating a unique regional identity. The Yao people mainly live in towns like Bibei, Youxi, and Dongping, with a strong Yao cultural presence. Traditional customs like the Panwang Festival and Yao embroidery are listed as national and provincial intangible cultural heritage. The county boasts abundant natural attractions, including Nanling National Forest Park and the Ruyuan Grand Canyon, with 102 peaks over 1,000 meters, including Shikengkong, the highest peak in Guangdong. With beautiful natural surroundings, it's perfect for eco-tourism and outdoor activities. The area has a well-developed transport network, with highways like the Jinggang'ao Expressway and Leguang Expressway passing through, and there are future plans to build Shaoguan Airport to improve accessibility even more. With its unique location, rich history, and stunning landscapes, Ruyuan Yao Autonomous County is definitely a place worth exploring.

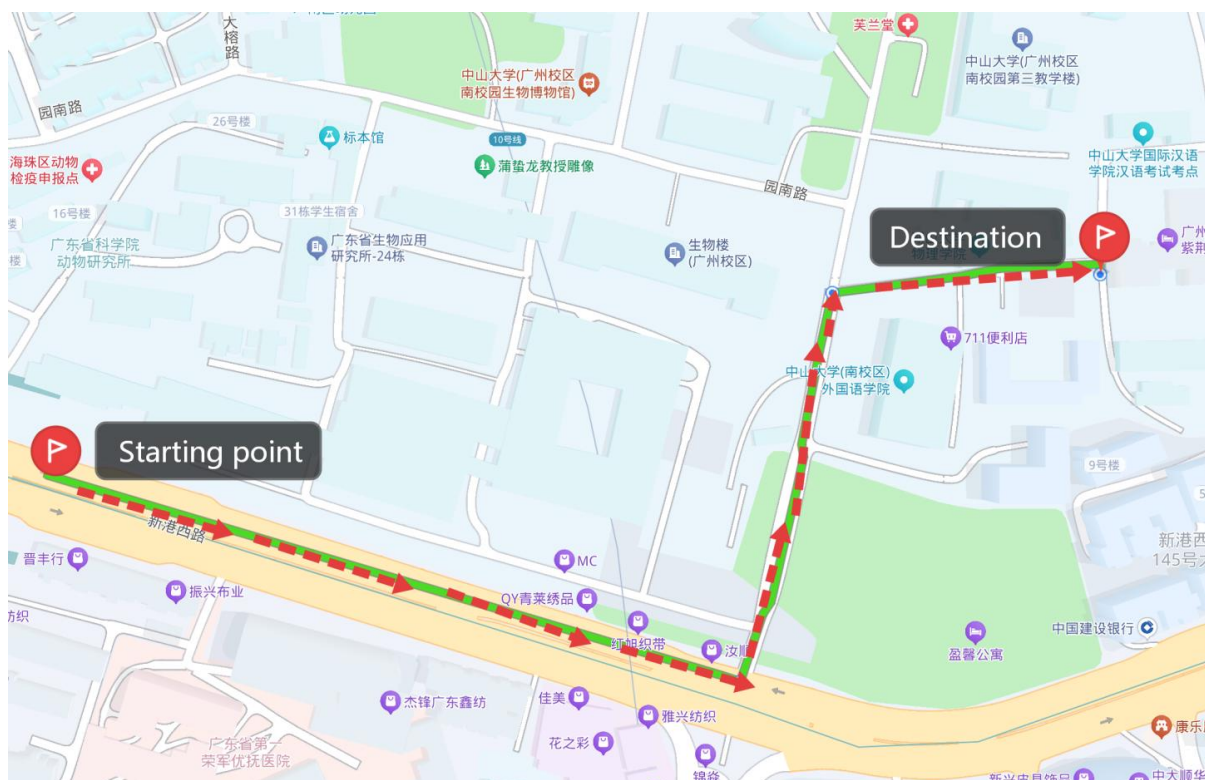

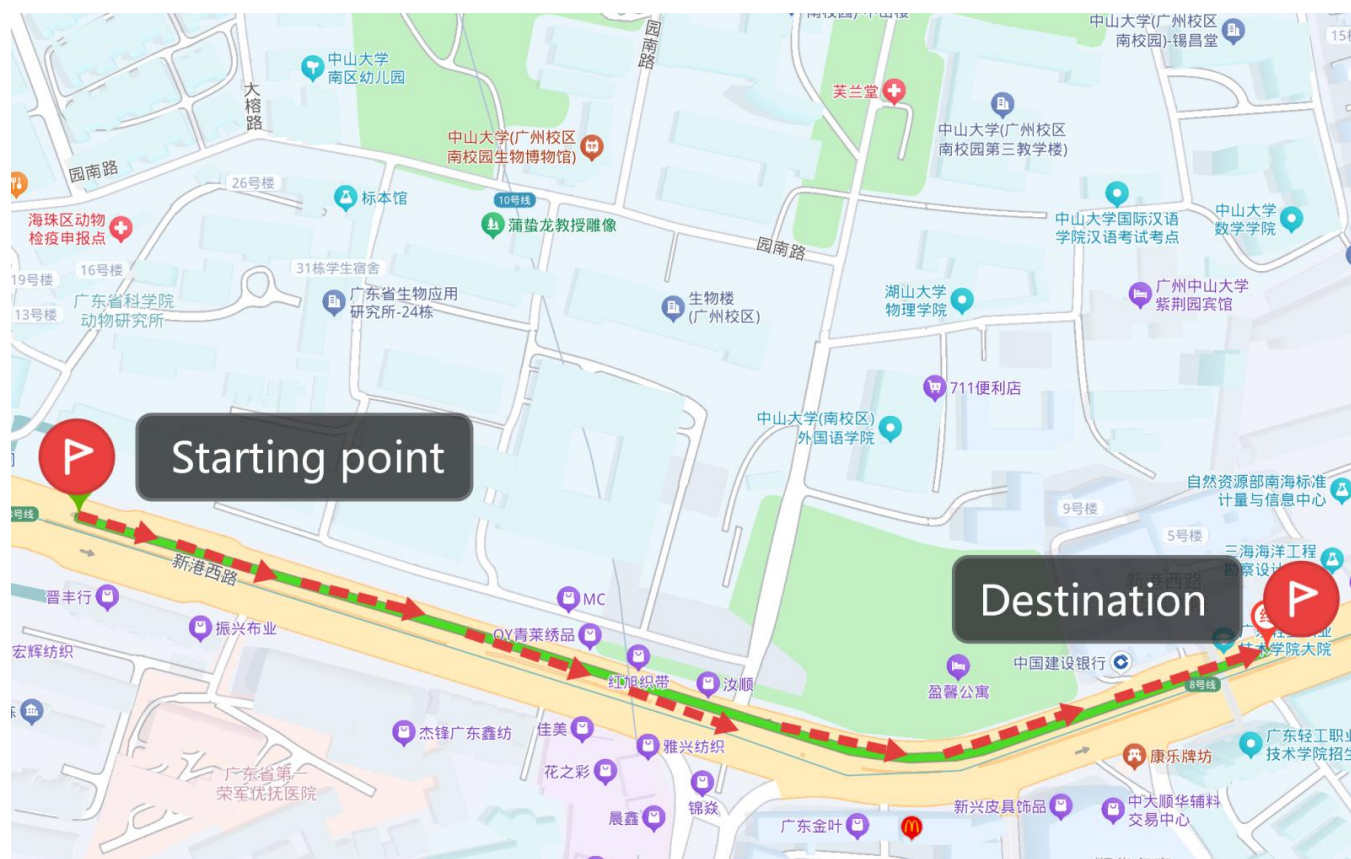
