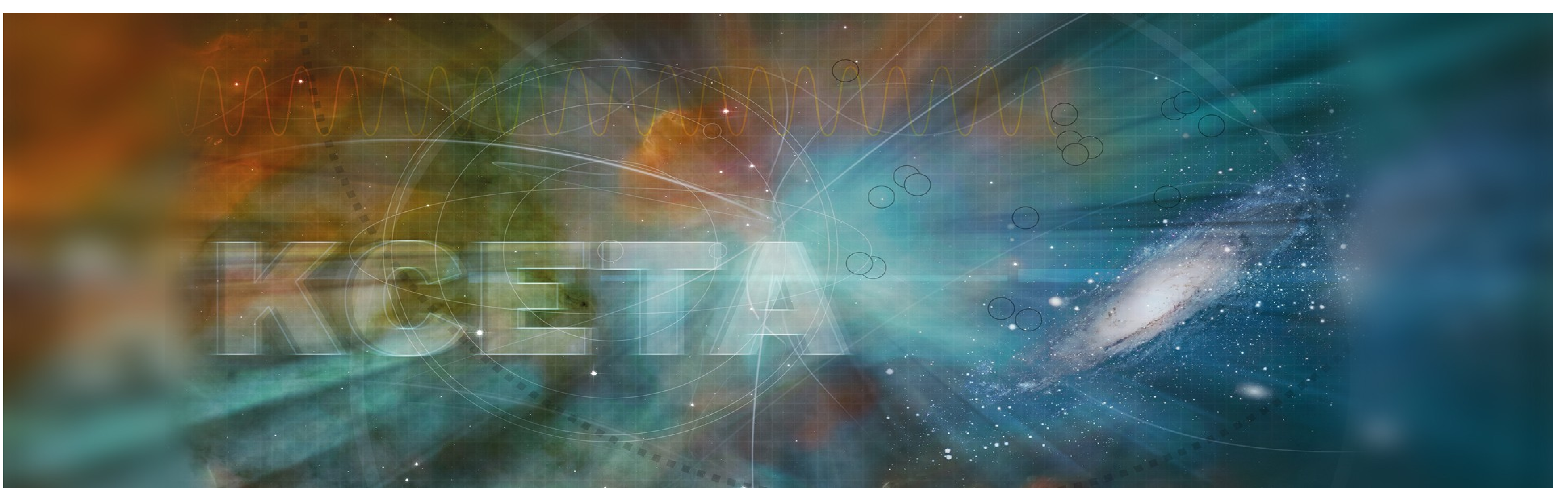

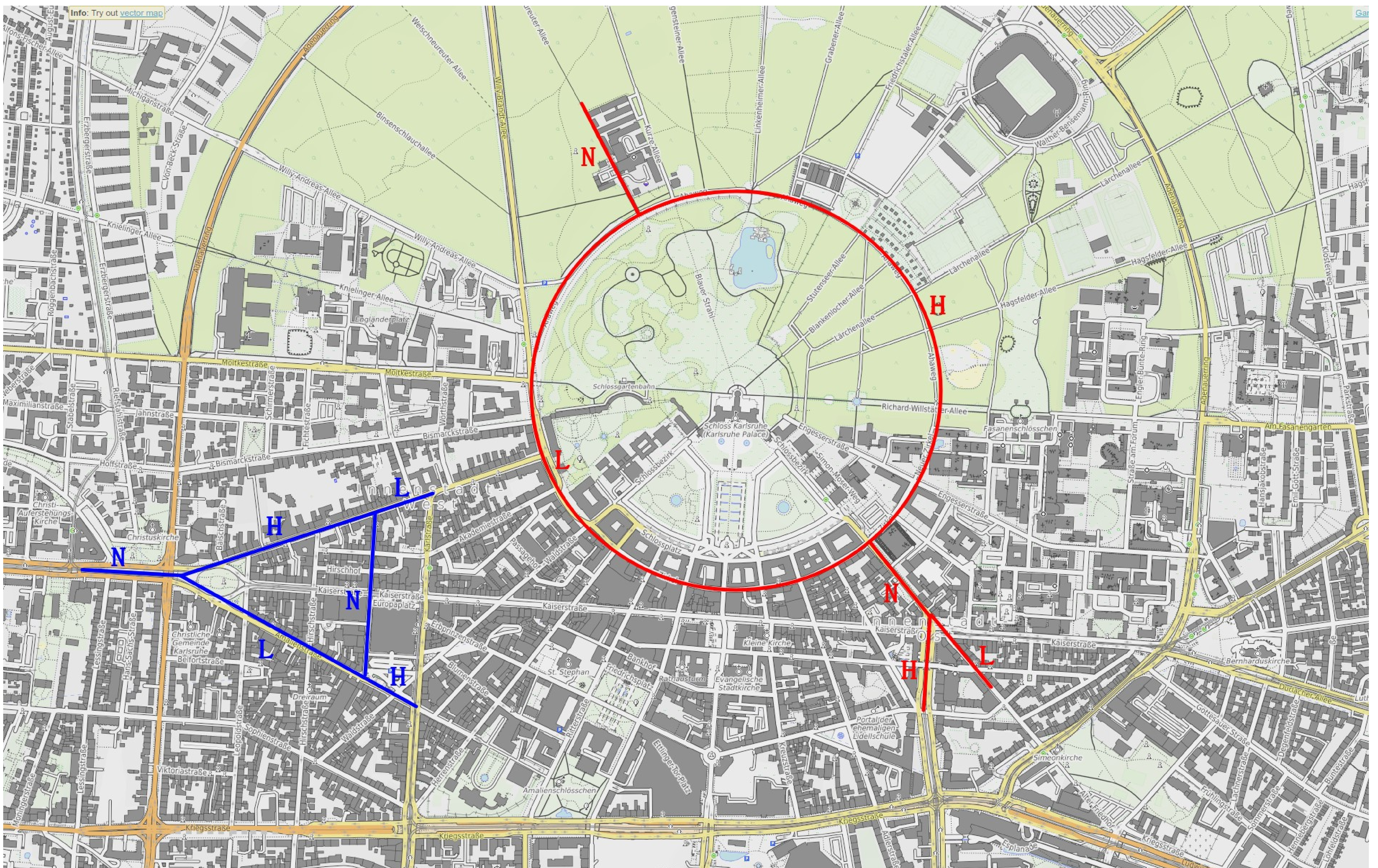
Leptogenesis

We will take a look at leptogenesis from two perspectives: we will review the conceptual and numerological reasons for whether or not leptogenesis is a compelling explanation of the baryon asymmetry in the Universe; and, given that the asymmetry in the simplest variants of leptogenesis can be computed without technical difficulty, we will use it as a basis to include more interesting dynamics and theory methods for particle cosmology.
