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DARWIN - A Low-Background, Low-Threshold Astroparticle Physics Observatory

I will present the science case and the status of DARWIN, a liquid xenon time projection chamber (TPC) with a target mass of $\tilde{~}40$ t. It will be sensitive to WIMP dark matter interactions down to the neutrino floor, the double beta decay of Xe-136, will allow for a precision measurement of low energy solar neutrinos, and will be sensitive to many other rare processes as well
