



Zoom and Slido separate




Our instant communication



Access pinboard








Poster Sessions

How to translate a poster session into the virtual space?

- Three poster sessions A, B and C, rotating three times e.g. B-1, B-2, B-3 for different time zones
- Please be **present** at least in one session to **qualify for publication in TNS**, better twice
- Mini orals \rightarrow Micro orals (1 min pitch for each poster)
- Late micro orals on on Indico
- Write down poster ID (shown in lower left corner) to visit that poster later
- Visit Zoom room of poster presenter via "Poster List"
- "Hop" between different posters
- Poster presenters can show poster, slides, video, or even live equipment!
- Register your poster room if not yet done so → "Presentation Instructions"


