Continuing the Collaboration with COVID

EPICS Collaboration Meetings are less frequent and depend on virtualization

- ICALEPCS October 2019 last fully in person meeting, limited to one day due to conference
- Fritz Haber Institute October 2020 all virtual
- Canadian Light Source July 2021 all virtual
- Cosylab in Ljubljana September 2022 hybrid, first meeting with in-person participation since the pandemic began, remote participation also possible



Continuing the Collaboration with COVID

- Meetings have been once per year rather than twice, missing Asian locations
- Time zone differences make it difficult for virtual meetings to attract an international audience
- Given the importance of sharing developments and in person interaction, the EPICS Council is working toward returning to 2 meetings per year and in person or hybrid meetings keeping travel advisories in mind

Continuing the Collaboration with COVID

Code-a-thons and Document-a-thons have continued at one per year

- SLAC May 2022, hybrid
- ESS March 2021, virtual
- Diamond February 2020 in person, just before COVID induced shutdowns began

 Various working groups have continued to meet virtually and core developer working group planning a meeting at Brookhaven in October



Collaboration goals

Goals

- Two meetings per year using Europe, Americas, Asia rotation
- Code-a-thon At least once a year
- Document-a-thon At least once a year

 Next EPICS Collaboration Meeting is being planned in the US for Spring 2023
