



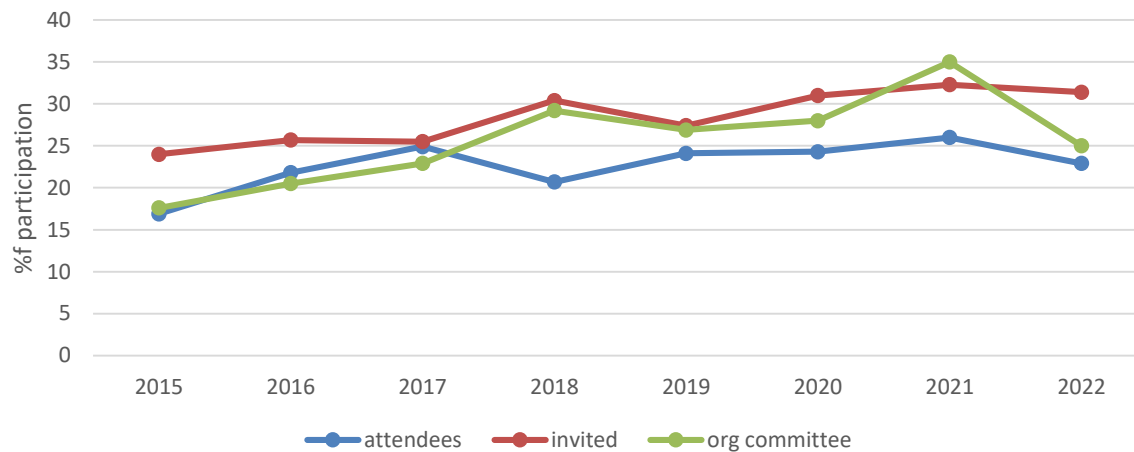

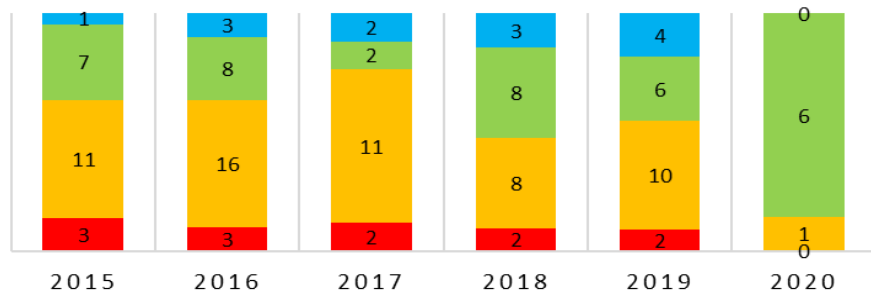

# Normalised number of conferences: %female participation

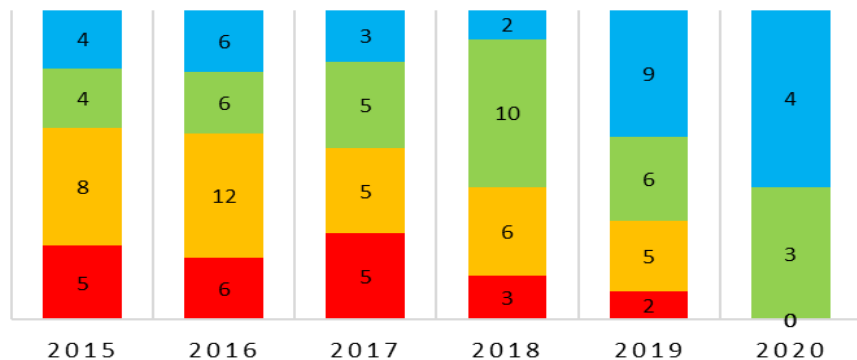
## %F ATTENDEES

■ <10% ■ 10-20% ■ 20-30% ■ >30%



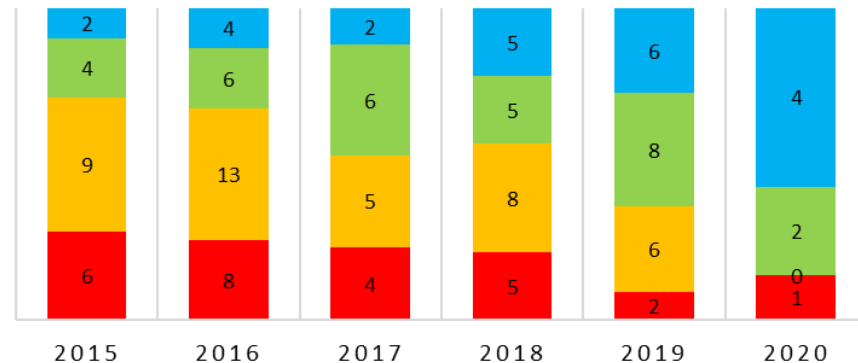
## %F INVITED SPEAKERS
