

Associated Members of Commissions.

From IUPAP's Internal Regulations:

Commissions may have important links to other IUPAP Commissions or Working Groups, scientific unions or international organizations. To maintain these links, each Commission may propose to the Executive Council the nomination of members of these groups as associated members to the Commission. IUPAP Associate Territorial Members can also submit nominations of associated members to Commissions at the time of or immediately after the General Assembly during which the new composition of Commissions is decided. It may also happen that proposals of associated members to Commission arise during the discussion about the election of regular Commission members. The Executive Council will consider these proposals and appoint associated members to the Commissions before the GA immediately following the one at which regular Commission members are elected. Associated members do not vote at Commission meetings, are not eligible for travel funds and their term ends simultaneously with that of regular Commission members.
