

What is ACCU?

- Advisory Committee of CERN Users (ACCU)
- Forum for discussion between CERN Management and the representatives of the CERN Users community (Delegates)
 - to review the practical means taken by CERN for the work of Users
 - Website where you can read the mandate: https://accu.web.cern.ch/
- Each member State: 1 or 2 Delegates (depending on size)
- Each associate members: 1 Delegate
- Non-member states: 4 Delegates (organised in regions)
- CERN: 2 Delegates
- The Chairperson of ACCU is elected from among the Delegates.
- I am the Swedish == delegate from Jan 2020 but I have never been to a meeting in person yet

ACCU Meetings

- ACCU meetings are held four times per year.
- The meetings are closed
 - agenda, minutes and uploaded presentations are open and are accessible by anyone (with exceptions)

 - The meetings have minutes, so you can check everything we discuss
- The meetings of ACCU are attended by a member of the Directorate, often the DG, by the Head of the Users' Support, who also acts as ACCU Secretary, as well as by other members of the CERN Management and Departmental Representatives.
- A representative of the CERN Staff Association also attends the meetings.






Last year


- I sent you a form to fill and 55 of you answered.

 - Some other questions or comments I have been following up since






Some general stats







Does your health insurance cover you at CERN?

The food

- You want:
 - Better labelling of allergens/ingredients
 - Better vegetarian/vegan options
 - Better prizes
 - Better taste
 - More options (including food trucks)
 - A store

This aligns with the general CERN population across countries!

The food

- A lot of work on improving the restaurants in the last months
 - Renovations (restaurants, terraces, bathrooms), increased capacity, new vending machines
- New Executive Chef with quality and consistency focus
- Vegan offer to be developed together with vegetarian one
 - Round table to be organised by the end of the year withvegan/ vegetarian community
- Actions toward sustainable cooking will be planned
- Main allergens to be posted for all menus

Things you asked for/care about

- A better website/maybe one specific for Sweden
 - The users office has a new one https://usersoffice.web.cern.ch/
 - Includes newcomers guide: https://newcomersguide.web.cern.ch/
 - Is this enough? Check it out and let me know!
- Chargers for electric cars (another very popular demand)
 - CERN is trying out options!
 - New charging stations "11-22 kW" (fast charging) on site.
 - One pilot in Meyrin and one pilot in Prevessin.
 - Pending discussions with the legal service.

Things you asked for/care about

- Improvements in the hostels
 - B38 has been renovated and B39 has started renovation
 - Foyer Schuman is considering renovations
- Parking: bicycles, and cars (long and short term) (another hot point!)
 - bicycle shelters will be improved in Prevessin and Meyrin
 - Long-term parking in Meyrin for bicycles (ready soon?)
 - EDH request for long-term parking (bike/car)
 - Identification of all the existing "non declared" parking slots ongoing
 - Mainly used since decades but never put on the GIS leading to infractions
 - Officialize the 55 parking slots in the French part of Meyrin and the 30 in the Swiss part of Meyrin after checking with transport group and local users

Things you asked for/care about

- Safety biking (roundabout and bike lanes)
 - Plans on improving both, works to start next year
- Medical tests for dosimeters
 - Back in the day, users based at CERN could get the medical for the dosimeter on site (I did a few times myself), this is not possible anymore and with covid the situation became clearly inconvenient.
 - I'm still investigating this
- The looks of CERN!
 - Some of you find CERN not so beautiful in the common areas (some improvements are ongoing, at a slow pace)
 - Trees! Some trees were cut due to parasites and never planted again, I am also investigating this.

Hot topics for ACCU this year

- COVID protocols
- Insurance:
 - A new insurance model for users based at CERN is still in the works, hopefully soon
- The new nursery! (Le Jardin des particules)

- Waste management
- New Safety Incident Management (SIM) rules and tool (ongoing)
- Additional Mobility topics (including green plates), CERN trying new carsharing system
