## The Square Kilometre Array Observatory: Prospects for Relativistic Astrophysics

The SKA is now in the detailed design phase with construction scheduled to begin in early 2018, followed by early science from about 2020. A major component of its broad-ranging science program is focused on addressing questions in fundamental physics.
