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A new stellar cluster Gaia 2

We determine the atmospheric parameters of two members of a new stellar cluster Gaia 2. The low resolution spectra of the stars were obtained at TÜBİTAK National Observatory, using the RTT150 telescope (with 1.5 m). We announce the first results in the present study.

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
